Background

Pete Stolpman and Rajat Parr's Esoteric Partnership "Combe" means a "small sheltered valley within a vineyard" in French.

When Rajat Parr began making
Chardonnay alongside Stolpman in
the Lompoc Wine Ghetto back in
2010, he immediately campaigned to
plant Trousseau on Stolpman's
Ballard Canyon Limestone soils.
Vignerons in Jura seek out
Limestone for their Trousseau
plantings, and Rajat theorized that
Trousseau, a varietal that often has
difficulty achieving ripeness, would
flourish in the sunny, arid Ballard
Canyon wind tunnel.

Block 6 Trousseau / Block 4 Mondeuse

Harvest Date

August 30

Winery

Vinification

Immediately pressed prior to Native Fermentation

Vatting/Fermentation

Stainless Steel until 1.2 Brix

Cooperages & Elevage

Bottled under crown cap to finish fermentation, then disgorged and re-capped in early April 2023

Sensory

Pale pink in color with a plentiful mousse and a petite bead of bubbles. Insanely floral, notes of jasmine, and a ton of bright peach and plum. Racing acidity is already integrated into the wine's tactile richness. An amazing elevation of intensity in 2022!
